## AN ACT RELATIVE TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           **SECTION 1.** Chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby further amended by inserting after section 22 the following section:-

3           Section 22A. The division of industrial accidents shall publish on its web site a listing of all  
4 companies required to be covered by workers compensation insurance. The listing shall include: whether  
5 or not coverage is in effect; the effective dates of the policy; the holder or carrier of the policy; all  
6 industry codes associated with the policy. The Massachusetts workers compensation rating and  
7 inspection bureau shall provide the division of industrial accidents with all information needed to comply  
8 with this section.
