**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act promoting children safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by adding after the word “standards.”, in line 44, the following sentence:–
3 “Any motor vehicle used primarily for the transportation of pupils and having permanent seating
4 accommodations for and carrying not more than eight persons in addition to the operator shall be
5 painted in accordance with this clause no later than August 1, 2018.”
