## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to body worn cameras.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 104(e) of Chapter 253 of the Acts of 2020 is hereby amended by
- 2 striking the following language "(vi) a requirement preventing an officer from accessing or
- 3 viewing any recording of an incident involving the officer before the officer is required to make
- 4 a statement about the incident;" and inserting in place thereof the following:-
- 5 "(vi) a requirement allowing an officer to access or view any recording of an incident
- 6 involving the officer before the officer is required to make a statement about the incident;"
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
