By Ms. Haddad of Somerset, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1924) of Swan and others relative to the private school price rating formula Joint Committee on Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to chapter 71B approved private school pricing rating formula.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22N of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 257 of the
2 Acts of 2008, is hereby amended in the sixth paragraph by inserting after the first sentence the
3 following 3 sentences:-

4 The division shall establish a subsequent year price for a contractor for goods or services related
5 to special education as defined in section 1 of chapter 71B located within the commonwealth by
6 adding a per student annual adjustment amount to the current authorized price, so called. The
7 per student annual adjustment amount will be determined by multiplying the current authorized
8 price, so called, by a percentage factor, as determined on an annual basis by the operational
9 services division. The annual adjustment amount percentage for each cost component shall
10 correspond to the actual cost component structure of these programs.
