Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section one hundred forty-seven of chapter fifty-four of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new
- 3 sentence:
- 4 Provided, however, that notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, cities and
- 5 towns shall be reimbursed for their costs of conducting special elections, called to fill vacancies
- 6 in offices under this chapter, after certification of said cost by the state auditor.
