- The first paragraph of section 21 of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-
- The pharmacist filling a written, electronic or oral prescription for an opiate in schedule
- 4 II or III shall affix to the container a label a clear, concise warning that the opiates dispensed can
- 5 cause dependence, addiction and overdose.
