An Act regarding sharps and medications.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general law, or special law to the contrary, all
- 2 retailers, medical offices, hospitals and veterinarian clinics, and other providers that dispense
- 3 sharps to the general public be responsible to provide a sharps collection and disposal program at
- 4 their locations at no additional cost to the general public. The pharmaceutical manufacturers shall
- 5 be responsible for funding collection sites for medication waste.
