Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 91B of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in

2 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 4 the words, "subsections (b)

3 and (c)," and inserting in place thereof the following words:- subsections (b), (c), and (d),.

4 SECTION 2. Section 91B of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official

5 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (c) the following subsection:-

6 (d) To a voter qualified under the federal Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act
