An Act relative to unaffiliated voters.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapters 50 through 57 inclusive of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, are hereby amended by substituting the words “unaffiliated voter” for the phrase
- 3 “unenrolled voter” wherever the phrase “unenrolled voter” appears.
  
- 4 SECTION 2. The phrase “unenrolled voter” shall be changed to “unaffiliated voter” wherever it
- 5 appears in the regulations promulgated pursuant to Chapters 50 through 57 of the General Laws.
