#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act promoting sterilization during surgery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting, after section 184C, the following section:
- 3 Section 184D. Every hospital shall maintain in surgical and intensive care units, in a clear
- 4 and visible place the following directives:
- 5 (a) Wash your hands; (b) Clean the patient's skin with chlorhexidine antiseptic; (c) Place
- 6 sterile drapes over the patient's entire body; (d) Wear a sterile gown, hat, mask and gloves; (e)
- 7 Put a sterile dressing over the catheter site once the line is inserted.
