## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to the definition of a pharmacy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 112, section 39C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2005
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the word "infusion," in place of the word
- 3 fusionist, everywhere that the word fusionist appears in this section, and replacing the last
- 4 sentence of this section with the following sentence:
- 5 "For the purposes of this section, the term home infusion pharmacy shall mean a
- 6 pharmacy which dispenses pharmaceuticals, sterile intravenous drugs and nutritional products
- ordered by physicians to patients in their homes and other similar institutional sites of care as
- 8 determined by the board."
