An Act providing for continuing education credits flexibility.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (7) of Section 20 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 905 by adding:

3 A board member may petition the commission for a waiver of the yearly hours
4 restrictions due to extenuating circumstances, provided that the member completes the required
5 18 hours of training during their term.
