An Act relative to the use of crossbows in hunting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 64 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking, in
- 2 the title, the word "bows."

- 3 SECTION 2. Said section 64 is hereby further amended by striking the words "or any crossbow."
