An Act relative to the STEM advisory council.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 217 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as amended by Section 12 of
- 2 Chapter 165 of the Acts of 2014, is hereby amended in subsection (c) by striking out the word
- 3 "30" in the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following word: 35.
- 4 SECTION 2. Said section 217 is hereby further amended in subsection (c) by inserting
- 5 after the words "not-for-profit organization" the following words:-; provided further, that not
- 6 fewer than 12 members of the Council shall represent companies that employ STEM
- 7 professionals.
