An Act increasing voting opportunities and online voter registration awareness in public schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The first sentence of 42 E of the General Laws as appearing in chapter 51 is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the phrase, “at all locations where student may register for  
3 classes” the words: - and prominently publicize in said location the availability of these forms at  
4 site location. The phrase : - A prominent link to the appropriate page of the Office of Secretary  
5 of State’s website for individuals to participate in online voter registration will be placed on the  
6 school’s official homepage is added to the end of the section.
