### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act granting equal access to original birth certificates to all persons born in Massachusetts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2B of chapter 46 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking, in line 3, the words "on or before July 17, 1974
- 3 or after January 1, 2008" and by striking in lines 4 and 5, the words "on or after January 1,
- 4 2008."
