In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act requiring disclosure of provider financial incentives.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 12D of Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2	inserting after "prescription", in line 13, the following sentence: -
3	If any natural person or entity, including, without limitation, a carrier or third party
4	administrator, including a pharmacy benefits manager, provides or offers to provide any financial
5	inducement or reward to a practitioner who switches to a therapeutically equivalent drug in place
6	of a drug prescribed by the practitioner, the prescriber shall disclose that fact to the patient.
7	SECTION 2. Section 12D of Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
8	inserting after "thereof", in line 23, the following sentence: -
9	If any natural person or entity, including, without limitation, a carrier or third party
10	administrator, including a pharmacy benefits manager, provides or offers to provide any financial
11	inducement or reward to a pharmacist to dispense a therapeutically equivalent drug in place of a

- 12 drug prescribed by a practitioner, the pharmacist shall disclose that fact to the prescribing
- 13 practitioner and the person who presents the prescription.
