An Act relative to consolidating multiple definitions of employee.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 148B of Chapter 149, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking the words “chapter 151”, in line 2, and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following: -

4 “chapters 151 and 152,”

5 SECTION 2. Section 1 of Chapter 152, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding  
6 after paragraph 6 after the word “payable”, in line 111, the following paragraph:-

7 “Any reference to an employee shall have the same meaning as in section 148B of  
8 Chapter 149 of the General Laws.”
