AN ACT RELATIVE TO OPTOMETRISTS SCOPE OF PRACTICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 66B of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting, in the first paragraph, after the words "except for those listed in
- 3 schedule" and inserting after the following new words: "III through"
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 66B of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition,
- 5 is hereby amended by striking the last sentence in its entirety and inserting the following new sentence:
- 6 "For the purposes of this section and section 68B, the term "therapeutic pharmaceutical agents" shall
- 7 mean those pharmaceutical agents required for the diagnosis, prevention, management or treatment of
- 8 abnormal ocular conditions or diseases."
