Balsler and others for legislation to authorize the Commissioner of Mental Health to have supervision over the provision of mental health services to prisoners. **In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act to improve mental health services in places of incarceration.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of Chapter 19 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph:-

3 The commissioner of mental health shall have supervision over the provision of mental  
4 health services to prisoners in the custody of the department of correction or any House of  
5 Correction, including review and approval of any contract between the department of correction  
6 and any other entity concerning the provision of mental health services, and shall establish  
7 minimum standards for the effective delivery of such services. At least once each six months  
8 the commissioner shall audit each state correctional facility and House of Correction to  
9 determine compliance with the minimum standards. In exercising its supervisory authority, the  
10 commissioner shall collect data regarding the provision of mental health services as necessary to  
11 promote improvements in such provision, including such data as may be required in order to  
12 obtain funding from the federal government for services to prisoners with mental health needs.
