Resolve providing for an investigation and study by a special commission relative to consumer protections with regard to cemeteries and crematories.

- 1 Resolved, Resolved,
- 2 Resolved, that a special commission is hereby established for the purpose of conducting
- 3 an investigation and study of equitable costs with regards to cemeteries, burials, and crematories.
- 4 The commission shall consist of the house and senate chairs of the Joint Committee on
- 5 Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure, who shall serve as co-chairs of the
- 6 commission; 1 member to be appointed by the Senate President, 1 member to be appointed by
- 7 the Speaker of the House of Representatives; 1 member to be appointed by the Senate Minority
- 8 Leader; 1 member to be appointed by the House Minority Leader, the Undersecretary of the
- 9 Executive Office of Consumer Affairs and Business Regulation or his/her designee; and 1

- 10 representative from each of the following organizations: the Massachusetts Funeral Directors
- 11 Association and the Massachusetts Cemetery Association.
- Such investigation and study shall include, but not be limited to;
- 13 (a) the range of costs of services provided by funeral homes, cemeteries, and crematories,
- (b) differences in costs between private cemeteries and public cemeteries,
- 15 (c) differences in costs between different religious cemeteries and secular cemeteries, and
- 16 (d) separating collection of payment of services provided by cemeteries and crematories
- 17 from funeral homes.
- The commission shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study,
- 19 and its recommendations on or before November 15, 2014.
