- 3 SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after 4 section 224 the following new section: -
- 5 Section 225. In efforts to increase public awareness of and education on the importance
- 6 of folic acid to patients, families and health care providers, the department of public health shall
- 7 administer a folic acid awareness initiative. Said department as part of the initiative shall
- 8 consider efforts to ensure that women receive the following daily recommended dosage levels of
- 9 folic acid to prevent neural tube defects: 400 micrograms (mcg) for women of childbearing age;
- 10 and 600 mcg for women during pregnancy. Said department shall also consult with statewide
- 11 maternal and child health organizations and various state programs, including but not limited to
- 12 MassHealth, to promote folic acid awareness.
