- 1 SECTION 1: As so appearing in the Massachusetts General Laws, 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 Section 34 of chapter 53 is hereby amended by inserting after the last sentence the following:-
- 3 "Each ballot shall offer “None of the Above” as a voting option."
