## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act to prevent deaths by fire.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 146 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting at the end of thereof the following section:
  "Section XX. Effective January 1, 2015, all newly constructed one and two family residential dwellings shall include an automatic standalone fire sprinkler system installed in accordance with NFPA-13D and MGL 146, Section 81.

  SECTION 2. For the purposes of this Act, an "automatic standalone fire sprinkler system", is a system where the above ground piping only serves fire sprinklers.
