An Act relative to elevator inspection fines.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 65 of chapter 143, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following:-
- 3 The department shall provide notice of expiration of inspection certificate to the owner or
- 4 operator at least 90 days prior to expiration. The notice shall include, but not be limited to,
- 5 explanation of fines imposed by this section. An owner or operator of an elevator shall not be
- 6 issued fines as prescribed by this section unless seasonable notification of expiration was issued
- 7 by the department.
