An Act relative to public records.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 7c of Chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 147, after the word “privacy” the  
3 following:

4 “including material related to any review of conduct of police officers which could result  
5 in disciplinary action.”
