An Act relative to the safe transfer of individuals in emergency situations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, a law enforcement officer, while in the performance of his duties, shall, in the case of a  
3 serious injury or death of an individual’s spouse, sister, brother, mother, father or child, transport  
4 or shall designate someone to fulfill his duty to transport such individual to a medical facility or  
5 hospital if such transport is requested.
