An Act relative to the Plymouth Nuclear Power Plant.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the owners of
- 2 Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station, located in the town of Plymouth, shall perform a weekly test of
- 3 its comprehensive nuclear safety and alarm system; provided that said test shall occur each
- 4 Monday at the same hour each week.
