An act relative to personal injury protection litigation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 34M of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the last sentence of the fourth paragraph the
- 3 following sentences:
- 4 If after the commencement of any such action, but before judgment, the insurer makes payment
- 5 of any amount that is due and payable, the court may still assess costs and reasonable attorney's
- 6 fees for the bringing and prosecuting of the action. Interest, running from the commencement of
- 7 the action shall be assessed on all amounts adjudged to be due and payable in any such action, at
- 8 the same rate as interest is assessed for breach of contract actions in the Commonwealth.
