## AN ACT ELIMINATING AGE DISCRIMINATION IN THE MASSHEALTH PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter one hundred and eighteen E is hereby amended by adding at the end
- 2 thereof, the following new language:
- 3 --The Division shall ensure that the income and asset criteria for individuals over age 65 shall be no
- 4 stricter than the income and asset eligibility for disabled individuals under age 65 as of July 1, 2008.
