An Act to permit the setting of both cash bail and pretrial conditions in domestic violence matters .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 42A of Chapter 276 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008 official
2 edition is hereby amended in line 7, after the words “terms of” by inserting the following:-

3 “bail or”.

4 SECTION 2. Section 58B of said chapter 276 is hereby amended in line 2 after the words
5 “pursuant to” by inserting the following:-

6 “section 42A or”.

7 SECTION 3. Section 58B of said chapter 276 is hereby further amended in line 2 after the words
8 “section 58A”; by inserting the following:-

9 “or section 87”.
