An act regarding smoke detectors in condominiums.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 26c Chapter 148 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following word after "hotels,":-

4 Section 2. Section 26c Chapter 148 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in
5 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

6 Section 26c1/2. Inspection of Condominium Units

7 Condominiums units, as defined in Chapter 183a, Section 1 and equipped with automatic
8 smoke or heat detectors, shall be annually inspected for working condition by the head of the city
9 and town fire department for compliance with the requirements of this section.
