## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act directing the State Board of Retirement to grant certain retirement benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary and for the
- 2 purpose of promoting the public good, the State Board of Retirement shall pay Virginia Wise,
- 3 the surviving spouse of Raymond Wise, an officer of the Bridgewater State College Police
- 4 Department retirement benefits as provided under section 94 of chapter 32 of the General Laws.
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of June 29, 2004.
