An Act protecting public employees..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 265, Section 13D is amended striking the section in its entirety and
- 2 replacing it with the following: "Whoever commits an assault and battery upon any public
- 3 employee when such person is engaged in the performance of his duties at the time of such
- 4 assault and battery, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year nor more than
- 5 10 years in a house of correction or by a fine of not less than ten thousand nor more than twenty
- 6 five thousand dollars."
