In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to the payment of an agency service fee .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 12 of Chapter 150E of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following new paragraph:
- The commonwealth or any other employer shall require as a condition of employment the payment on or after the thirtieth day following the beginning of such employment a service fee to
- 5 the employee organization which in accordance with the provisions of this chapter, is duly
- 6 recognized by the employer or designated by the commission as the exclusive bargaining agent
- 7 for the unit in which such employee is employed; provided, however, that such service fee shall
- 8 not be imposed unless the collective bargaining agreement requiring its payment as a condition
- 9 of employment has been formally executed, pursuant to a vote of a majority of all employees in
- 10 such bargaining unit present and voting.
