In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act providing that dispute resolution procedures shall be available over issues arising during mid-term bargaining.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Section 9 of Chapter 150E of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph of said Section 9 and inserting in place thereof the following:-
- After a reasonable period of negotiation over the terms of a collective bargaining agreement or over mid-term bargaining issues, either party or the parties acting jointly may petition the board for a determination of the existence of an impasse.
- 6 Section 2. Chapter 1078 of the Acts of 1973, as most recently amended by Chapter 589 of 7 the acts of 1987, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new Section 5:-
- 8 Section 5. The dispute resolution procedures set forth in this Section 4A shall be 9 available to parties over issues arising during mid-term bargaining.
