An Act relative to restoration to service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 (2), of Chapter 32 of the MGL as appearing in the official edition
2 is hereby amended in lines 75 and 89 by adding the words “with the approval of the head
3 of any department in which the vacancy exists”, immediately following the words “to such
4 position” in line 75 and “to said position” in line 89.
