An Act relative to requiring a civil service exam in the Department of Transitional Assistance and the Department of Housing and Community Development.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding and general or special law to the contrary, the Division of  
2 Personnel Administration is required to conduct a Civil Service Exam for employees holding the  
3 title of Benefits Eligibility and Referral Social Worker A/B and C and D no later than one year  
4 after this law goes into effect.
