An Act relative to illegal immigration.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

- 3 Section 189. Any business facility found to be employing illegal immigrants shall be closed and
- 4 padlocked immediately for a period of 30 days.
