So much of the recommendations of the Department of the State Treasurer (House, No. 17) as relates to the Massachusetts State Employees Retirement System. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to the Massachusetts State Employees Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 139 of Chapter 25 of the Acts of 2009 is hereby amended by striking it in its entirety and
- 2 inserting in place thereof the following:
- 3 SECTION 139. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary,
- 4 employees of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation as defined in Section 8 of this Act
- 5 who are hired after the effective date of this act shall become members of the Massachusetts
- 6 State Employees' retirement system, and notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
- 7 special law to the contrary including, but not limited to, paragraph (c) of subdivision (8) of
- 8 section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, said system shall be responsible for all liability
- 9 attributable to said service of such employees. The liabilities attributable to any other service of
- 10 such employees shall be recoverable by the commonwealth pursuant to the terms of paragraph
- 11 (c) of subdivision (8) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws.
- 12 (This section shall take effect on January 1, 2010)
