An Act relative to defining employees classified in Group 4.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the Generals Laws, as appearing in the 2008 official edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting in section 3 (g), in line 293, after the word “supervisor,” the  
3 following new words: -- associate probation officers, probation officer, assistance chief  
4 probation officer, probation officer-in-charge, and day reporting center probation officer, first  
5 assistant chief probation officer, court officer I, court officer II, assistant and chief court officer,  
6 associate court officer, and court officer-in-charge
