An Act regulating chapter 136..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 16 of chapter 136 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the sentence "(T)he
- 2 performance of labor, business and work directly connected to retail sales on these days shall
- 3 also be allowed" the following:
  
- 4 and the provisions of clause (50) of section six of chapter one hundred and thirty six pertaining
- 5 to voluntariness of work and time and one half payments shall apply to these employees.
