2           and by the authority of the same as follows:

3           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the  
4           contrary, the state board of retirement shall allow Paula A. Carey living at 28 Brayton Road,  
5           Boston, MA 02135 to be nominated as an eligible option (d) beneficiary by George C. Axiotis,  
6           an employee of the trial court, as provided under section 12 of chapter 32.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
