An Act relative to food allergens.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The Department of Public Health must report to the legislature within 120 days of the
- 2 bills passage a comprehensive plan on whether it is feasible to require restaurants to use different
- 3 utensils, working stations and storage for foods that contain peanut oils or any other allergens
- 4 that affect individuals who are allergic to peanuts.
