*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 188 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking, in line 19, the figure “11” and inserting in place thereof
- 3 the following: - “50”.
