An Act relative to apprenticeship programs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Said section 11H of chapter 23, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
- 2 by striking out the definition "apprenticeship program" and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following definition:-
- 4 "Apprenticeship Program", a program which is registered with the division for
- 5 recruitment, selection, employment, training and qualification of apprentices, on public projects
- 6 and will commit to having apprentices on jobsites by 180 calendar days after start of contract.
- 7 SECTION 2. Said section 11H of chapter 23, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
- 8 by striking out the definition "apprenticeship program sponsor" and inserting in place thereof the
- 9 following definition:-

- "Apprenticeship Program Sponsor", a person, association, committee, organization,
 corporation, partnership, trust or other entity operating an apprentice program on public projects
- and will commit to having apprentices on jobsite by 180 calendar days after start of contract.
