An Act to define further teacher for retirement purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word “counsellor” in line 547 the following language: -

3 “, a school nurse certified by the Department of Education”.
