The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act pertaining to firefighter disability.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 “Chapter 32: Section 94(c). Massachusetts Firefighters Robert T. Kilduff Cancer
2 Network

3 Section 94C. (1) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a firefighters
4 cancer network shall be established for the purpose of providing advice, counsel, education,
5 treatment, medical, and spiritual guidance to firefighters afflicted with cancer and to their
6 families.

7 This cancer network shall be called the “Massachusetts Firefighters Robert T. Kilduff
8 Cancer Network.”

9 The Robert T. Kilduff Cancer Network shall be funded at inception by transfer of
10 \$100,000 in assets from the Critical Incident Stress Management Fund to the “Massachusetts
11 Firefighters Robert T. Kilduff Cancer Fund”
