AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SURVIVOR BENEFITS OF JOHN C. POH.

Whereas, The deferred operation for this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to make

retirement benefits, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public convenience., therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary
for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the state retirement
2 board shall pay a member survivor allowance to Lorraine J. Poh, widow of John C. Poh, effective on the
3 date of his death February 12, 2008 who was a member of the contributory retirement system, equal to the
4 amount she would have received if he had elected to take option (c) of section 12 of chapter 32 of the
5 General Laws when he retired on November 1987.
