An Act relative to making provisional employees in civil service positions permanent in those positions .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 31 of the general laws in hereby amended by adding the following new section:

3 SECTION ##. Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary, the personnel

4 administrator shall within sixty days of the effective date of this act, establish an examination

- procedure for the certification of provisional employees, as defined in section one of chapter
- 6 thirty-one of the General Laws, to permanent positions within the commonwealth and cities and
- 7 towns of the commonwealth. The administrator shall determine the form, method and subject
- 8 matter for such examination procedure for the certification of such provisional employees. Upon
- 9 completion of the examination process, the administrator shall certify any employee who served
- 10 in a civil service position as a provisional employee for a period on at least six months prior to
- 11 the effective date of this act or any employee who has previously passed a civil service
- 12 examination and is now serving provisionally without interruption in service for more than two
- 13 years. In the case of those employees serving in the labor service, the administrator shall certify
- 14 any employee who served in a civil service position as a provisional employee for a period on at

least six months prior to the effective date of this act. The provisions of this act shall not apply to positions in the police and fire service.
